The State of Idaho Board of Education mandates that applicants 16 and 17 years of age must submit written verification from the last school attended (or the school in which they would be enrolled) for meeting at least one of the following criteria prior to GED testing:

- home schooled
one (1) year or more behind in credits earned
expelled
pregnant or a parent
entering college, the military, or an employment training program
enrolled in an Adult Basic Education Program, in the Job Corps, or incarcerated

In working with the above-named student, I believe that circumstances prevent the student from returning to the traditional school setting. It is my recommendation that after meeting with this student AND parent or guardian, the student be allowed to enroll in a GED/HSE program, and participate in GED testing. I verify that the student meets one of the above criteria and is not enrolled in school.
